
Birds, pollinators, and other wildlife need diverse and healthy native habitat to survive and thrive. You can support them by growing diverse plants native to Central Maryland in your yard. Natives tend to be hardier and lower maintenance than most non-native plants. They are also adapted to our environment. The unique selection of hard-to-find, healthy native plants from local growers makes the Audubon sale a "Don't Miss" event for gardeners and wildlife enthusiasts.

Perennials, shrubs, and trees are specifically selected by Master Gardeners and Master Naturalists for the sale. Plants being sold this spring will soon be listed on our website, <https://www.centralmdaudubon.org/plant-sale>. Most [plants from 2018](#) will be sold this year as well as some new varieties.

Master Naturalists and Master Gardeners will be available to answer questions at the sale. They, as well as Audubon members, can help you choose the right plants to create a beautiful wildlife sanctuary at your own home.
